POWERPOINT

Each powerpoint slide should include: a heading/title, bulleted main ideas, & pictures/visuals/maps. All information can be found in your notes and textbook, but you are welcome to use other resources as well. Be sure you use the list of slide requirements below to guide your group work.

- **Slide #1:** title page with group names and presentation title
- **Slide #2:** geography of China (benefits for civilization)
- **Slide #3:** Shang Dynasty overview
- **Slide #4:** Zhou Dynasty overview
- **Slide #5-#6:** 3 Chinese philosophies
- **Slide #7:** everyday life in Ancient China (social classes)
- **Slide #8:** Qin Dynasty overview
- **Slide #9:** Han Dynasty overview
- **Slide #10:** important Chinese inventions
- **Slide #11:** Silk Road (what it is exactly, its importance, its impact in past and today)
- **Slide #12:** three (3) specific connections to another civilization we have learned about so far

PRESENTATION

Your group will need to prepare and practice your presentation. On March 18th & March 19th, you will be responsible for presenting part of this presentation to other members of our class. You will be graded on your ability to clearly explain the information in ALL of the slides without simply reading off of it.
